

The Oprah Winfrey Show




- Aired 1986 2011 (25 seasons)

80s Pop Music



BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN – "The Boss" "The hardest working man in show business"

- sold over 60 million records in the US
- 15 Grammy Awards
- Inducted into Rock and Roll HOF -1999
- #23 all-time best musician
 - -Rolling Stone



MADONNA – The "Material Girl"

- won 2 Grammy Awards and a Golden Globe
- sold over 200 million records worldwide
- 2006 Confessions tour top grossing tour for female artist
- worth \$850 million



MICHAEL JACKSON – The "King of Pop"



- sold 750 million records worldwide
- 13 Grammy Awards
- 13 #1 Hits
- Guinness Record Book "Most successful Entertainer of All Time"







