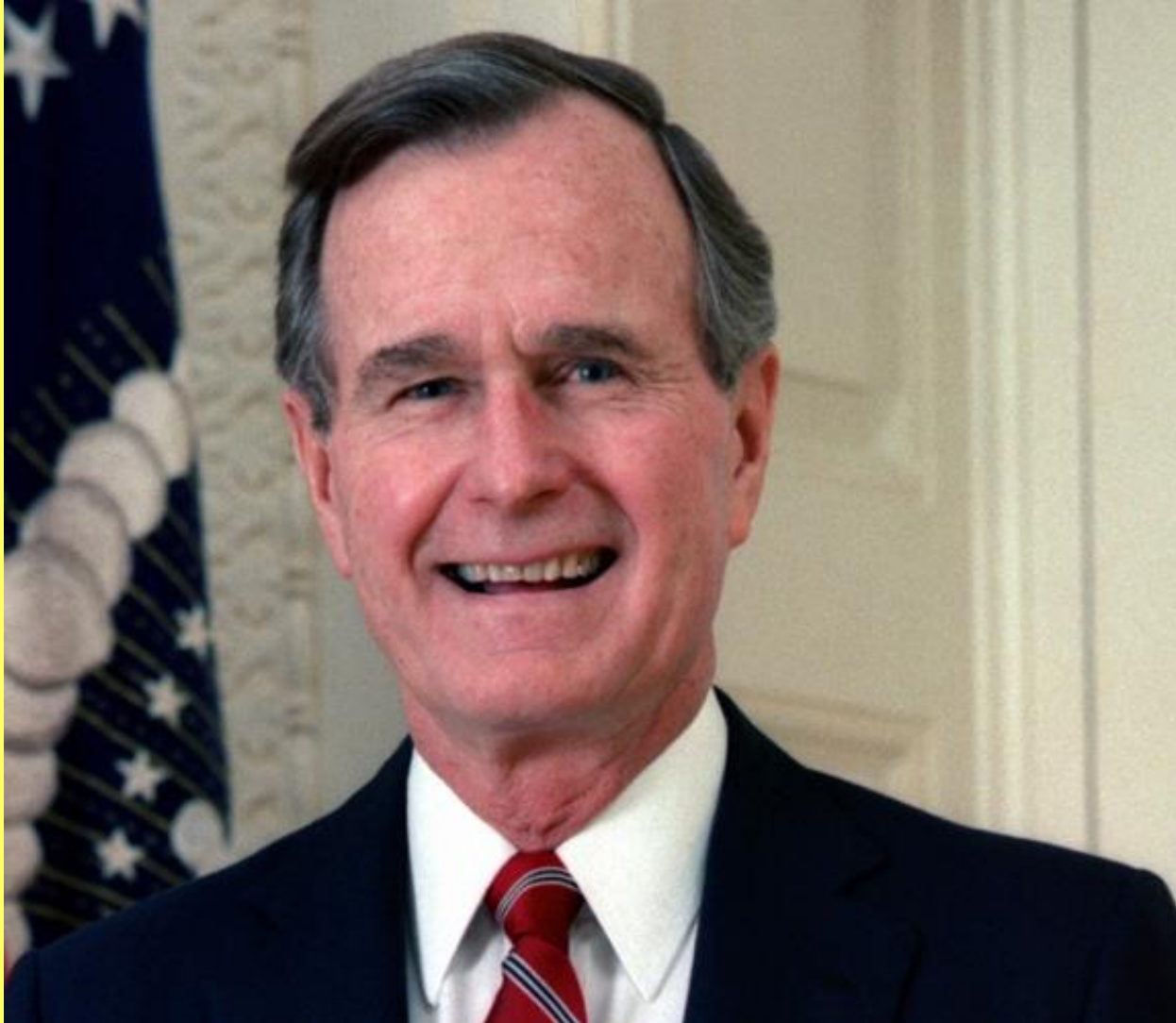

# September 2, 1944 Mission

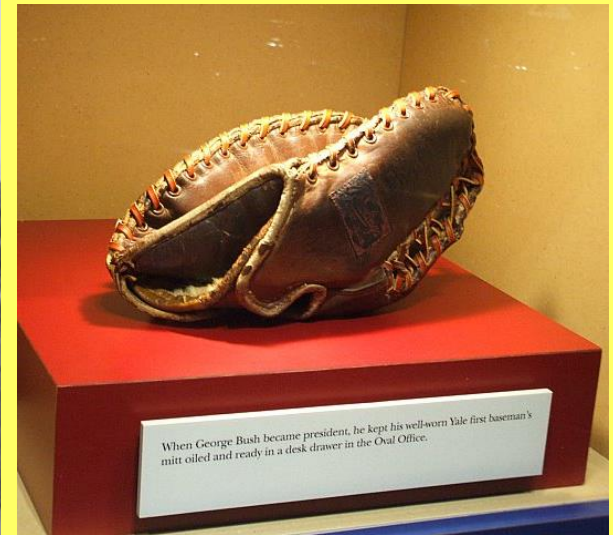
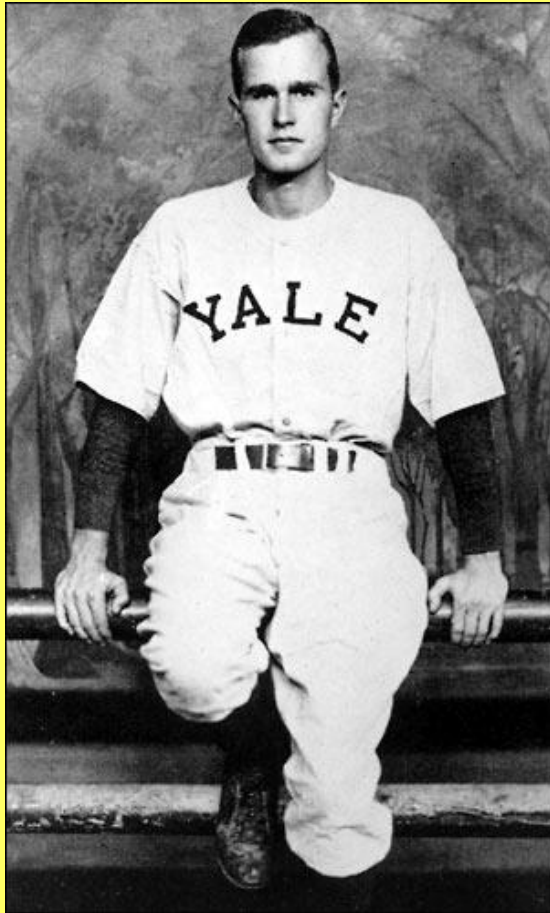
- Hit by enemy fire –engine on fire

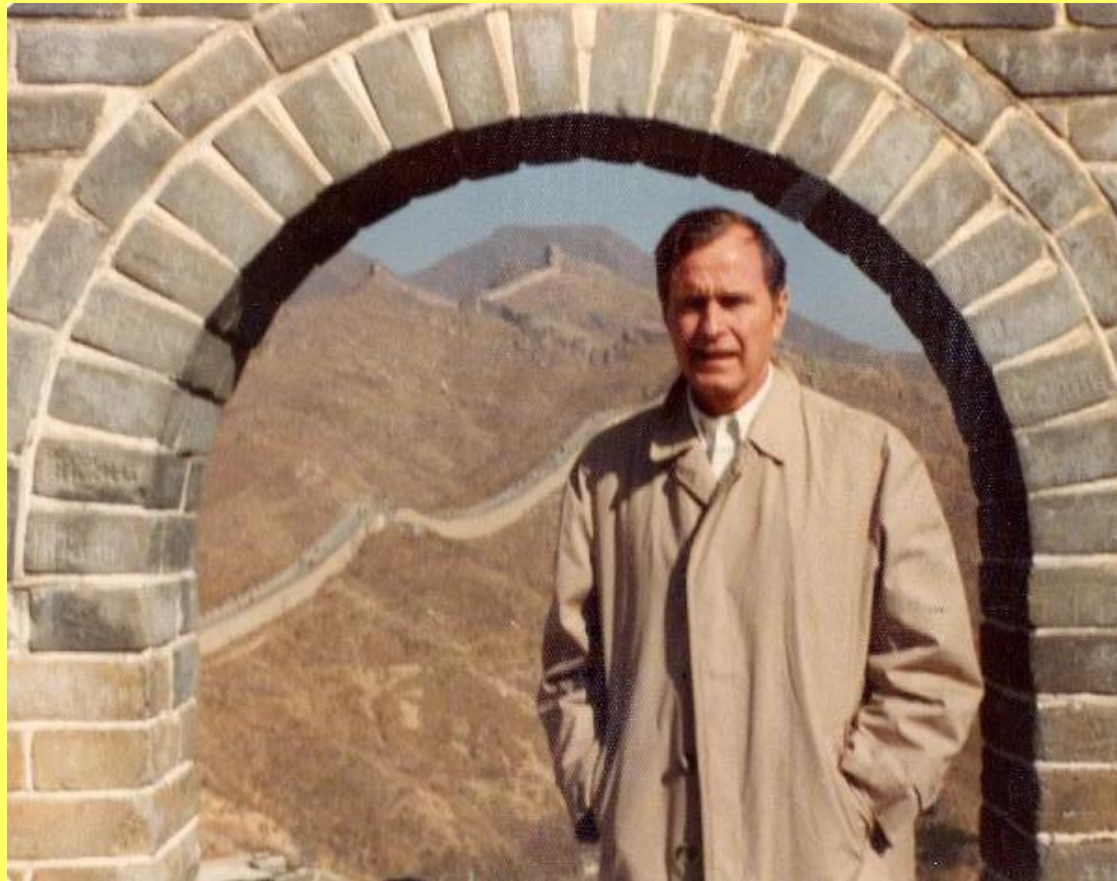
