



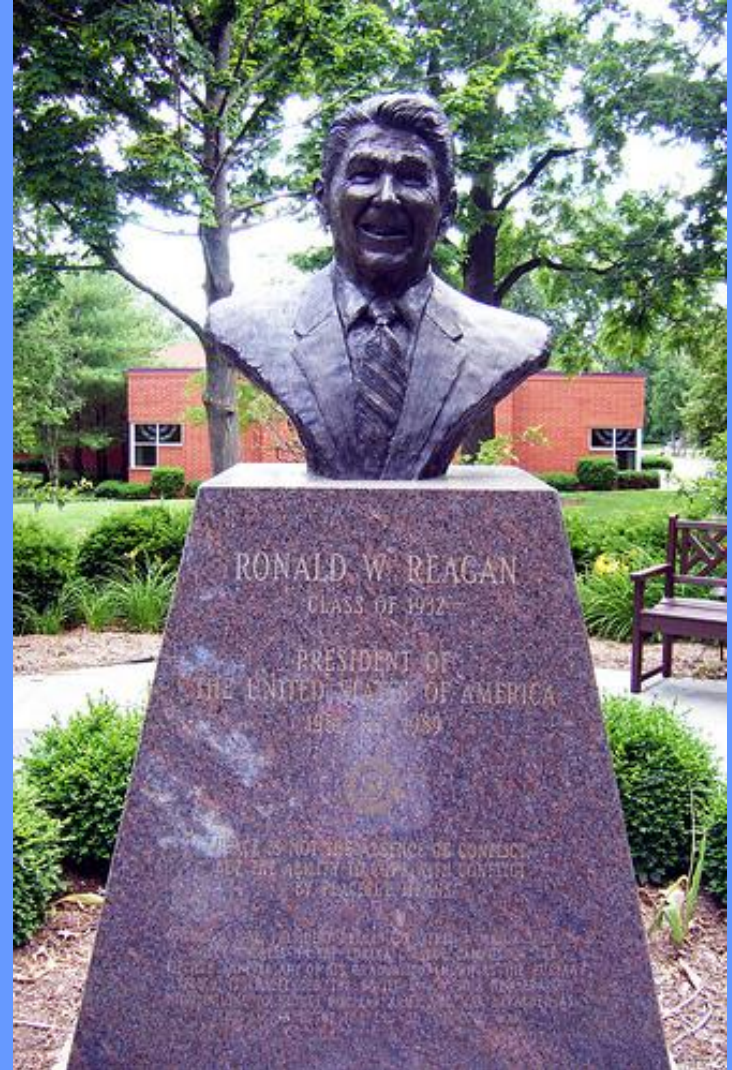

Actor (1937-65) "Mr. Norm" -made 54 films

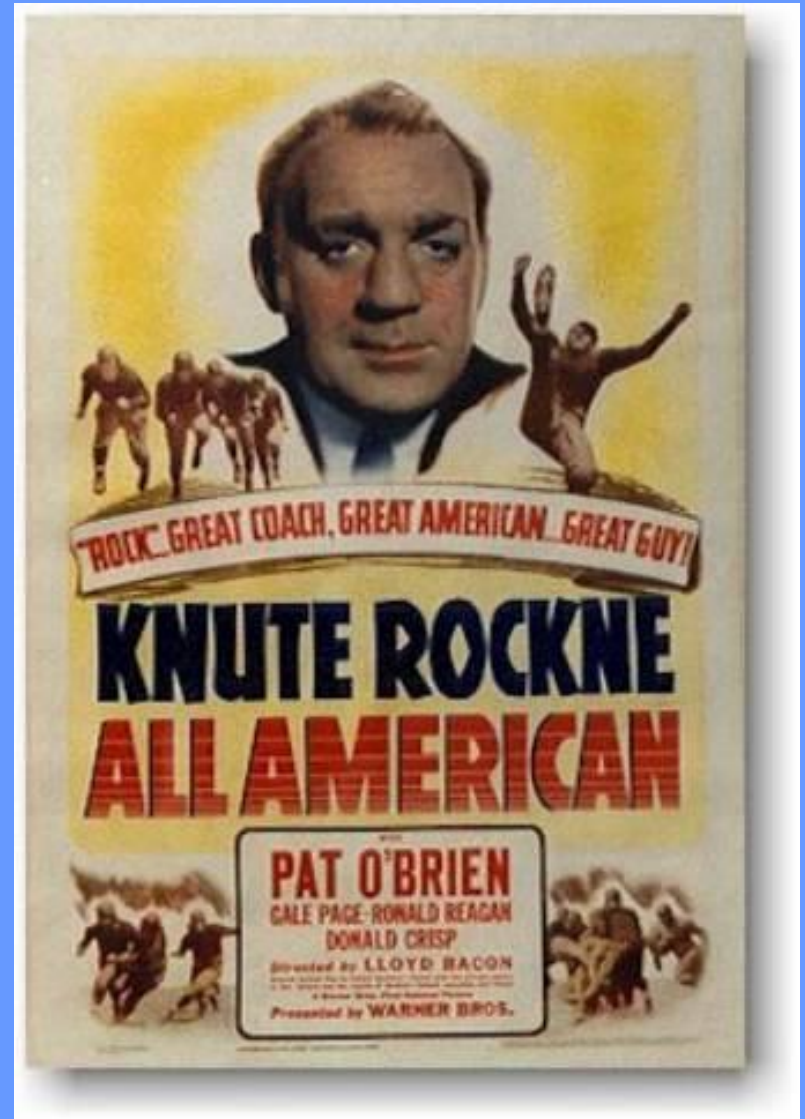

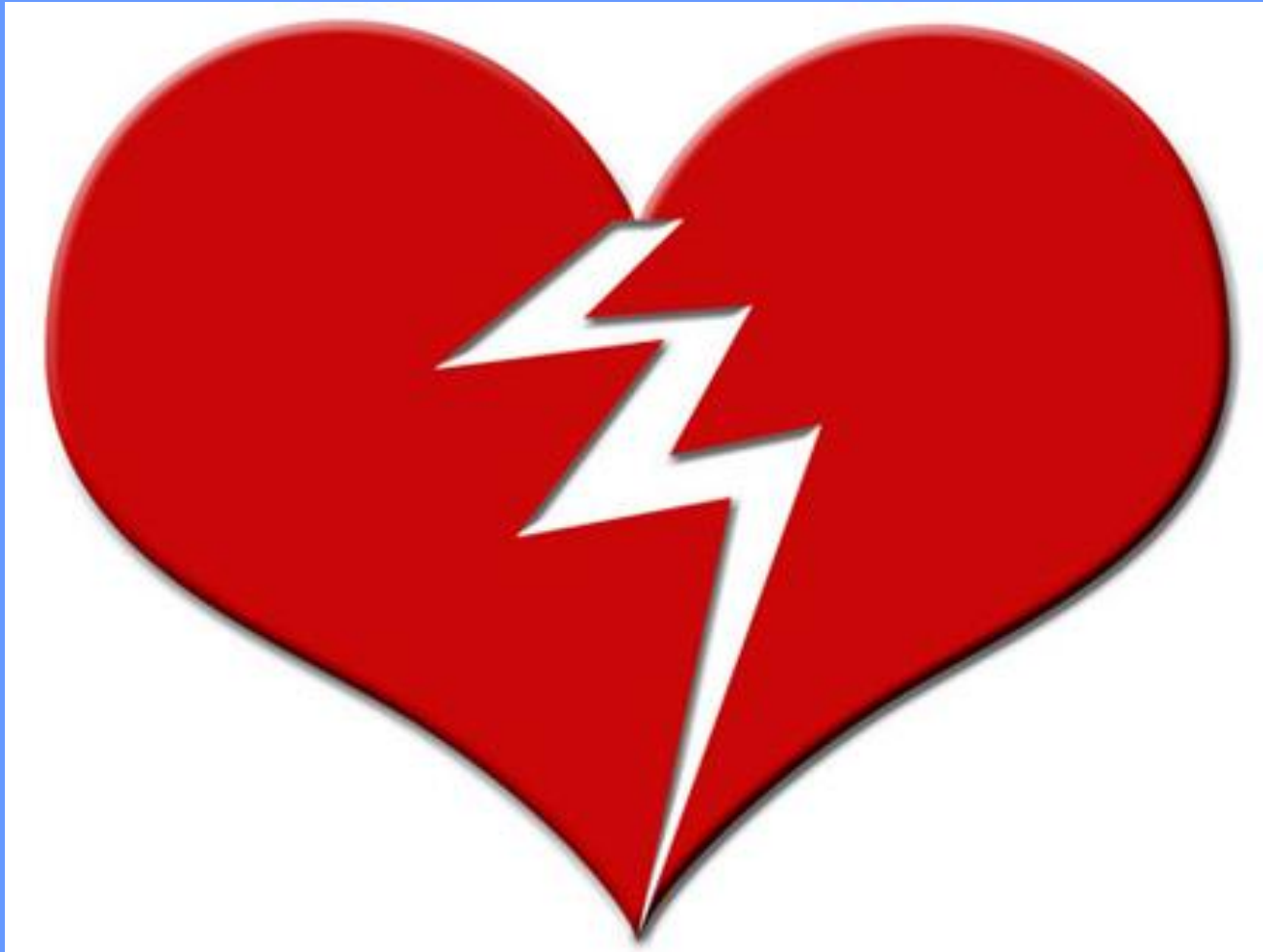

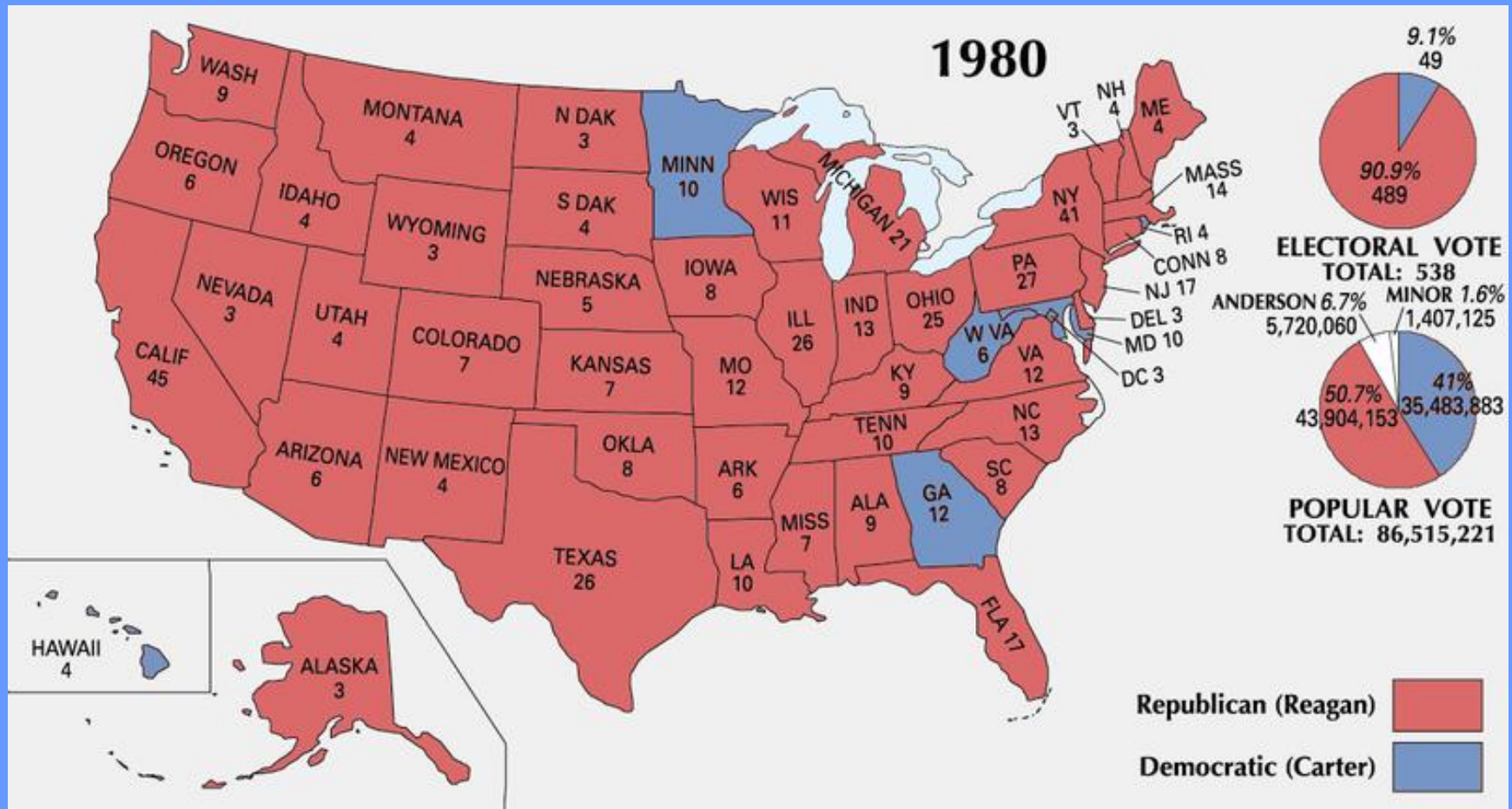

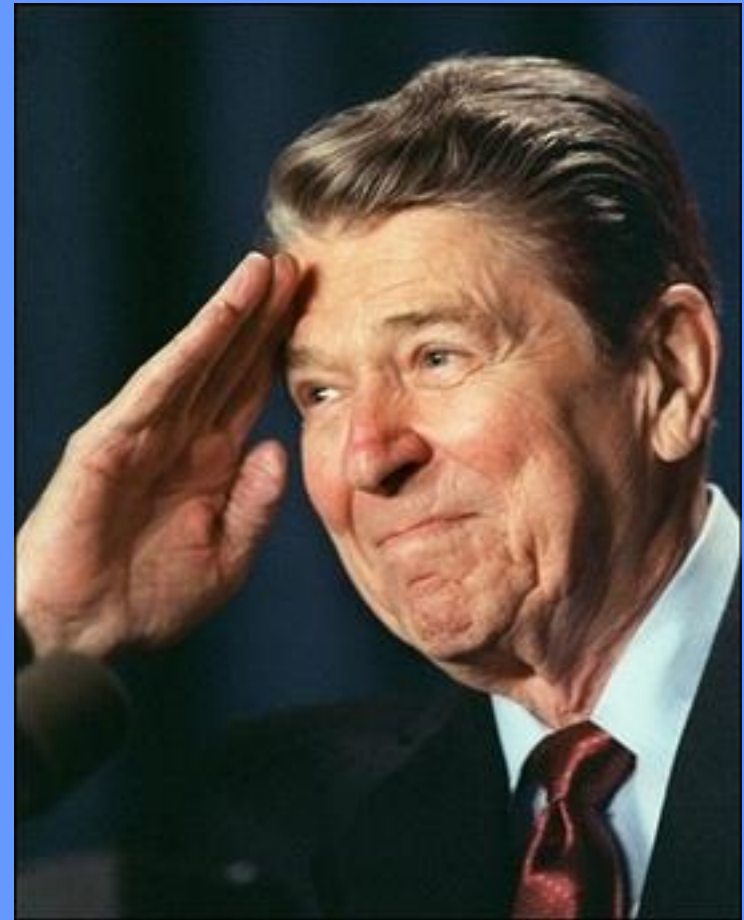

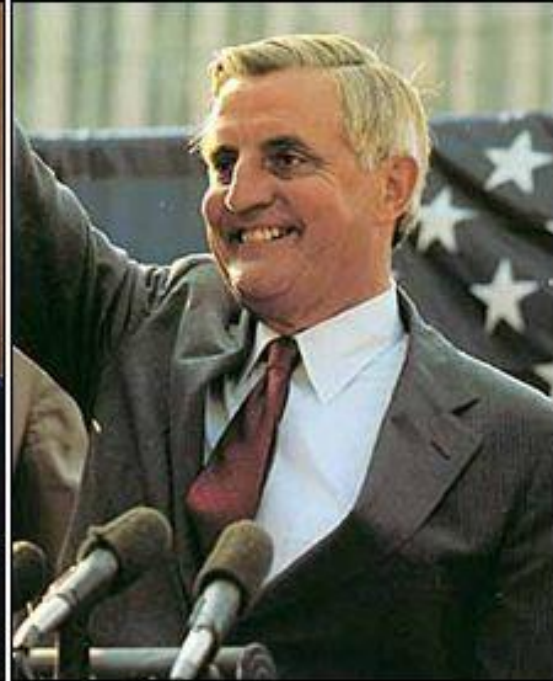
