Follow these step to get your iPad updated and ready for the school year.

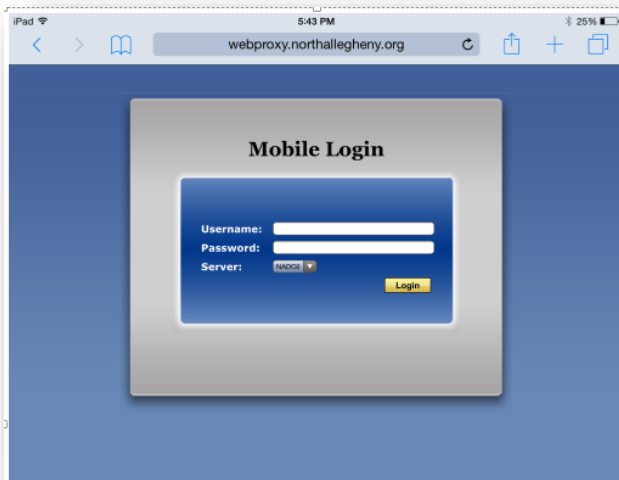

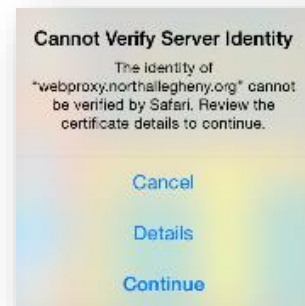
If needed, reconnect to your home wireless network. After you are connected you will need to follow these instructions to access the web:

New Procedures for iPad Use Outside of the NA Network

- North Allegheny School District has made enhancements to the security of student iPads that receive filtered Internet connections when used outside of the NA network. Anyone using a District iPad outside of the NA network will be required to authenticate with the District's Internet filter by entering their assigned NA credentials normally used to authenticate while at school.
- Once authenticated from a particular location (such as your home network) for the first time, any future attempts to access the Internet from that location may not require user credentials to be entered again.
- The "Mobile Login" screen that prompts for user credentials will be similar to the following:



Please note that in some cases, users may also receive the following message when logging in for the first time from outside of the District and will need to click "Continue" to proceed:



If you're experiencing issues, try this Mobile Login shortcut on your iPad.



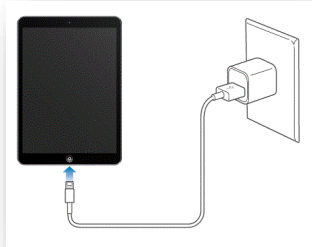

Make sure that your iPad is updated to the latest iOS (9.3.5). You can do this by going into Settings>Software Update>Click Install Now. *Please note that when you are installing an iOS update, you will want your iPad plugged into the charger so you do not run out of battery life.*
