## "Hour of Code" (also Computer Science Education Week)

This past week, HES students and staff participated in the "Hour of Code" sponsored by <u>Code.org.</u>

During this time students around the world got an introduction to computer programming- *no prior experience required*. Students (or teachers) choose how to spend their Hour of Code through game-based activities online or on their iPads. There are "unplugged" activities for those that don't want to use technology for the Hour of Code. This is a worldwide initiative with tens of millions of learners in over 180 countries! Games (also called tutorials) are designed for all ages in over 45 languages. The goals of the event are to "demystify" coding, showing that anyone can learn the basics, and to promote computer science as an option for future careers.
