



Line is one of the 7 Art Elements...


Line, Form, Shape, Color, Texture, Value, and Space




The **ELEMENTS** of art are the "building blocks" of art. We use these to **describe** works of art.

"A LINE is a dot that went for a walk." -Plaul Klee










