


Op Art creates effects through pattern and LINE! Your turn to make your own!



Step1: Draw a WAVY line left to right in the middle of your page.


Step2: Add 8 dots different lengths apart. You need a dot close to the edges of your paper.






Step3: Start connecting the dots with bumps. The edge dots connect to an imaginary dot off the page.
