

There are 2 kinds!






Color- reflection from your eye




Blue- Colors you can mix


Texture- how would these feels

How would these feel?











An exciting ELEMENT of art which depends on reflected light!










Warm/Cool Colors!

What is Monochromatic?




-Using ONE single color You can add *black* or white to that ONE single color








