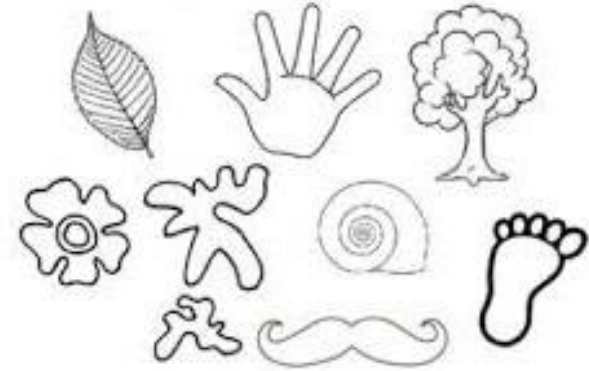


Shape – A line that connects to itself

ORGANIC SHAPES



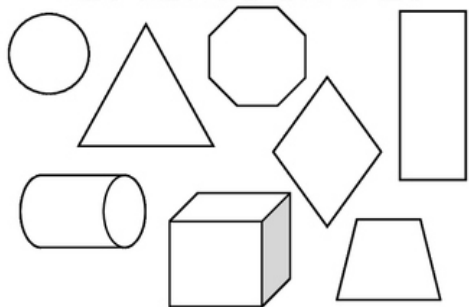
Color- reflection from your eye

Primary Color- Red, Yellow, Blue- Colors you can mix

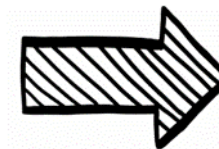


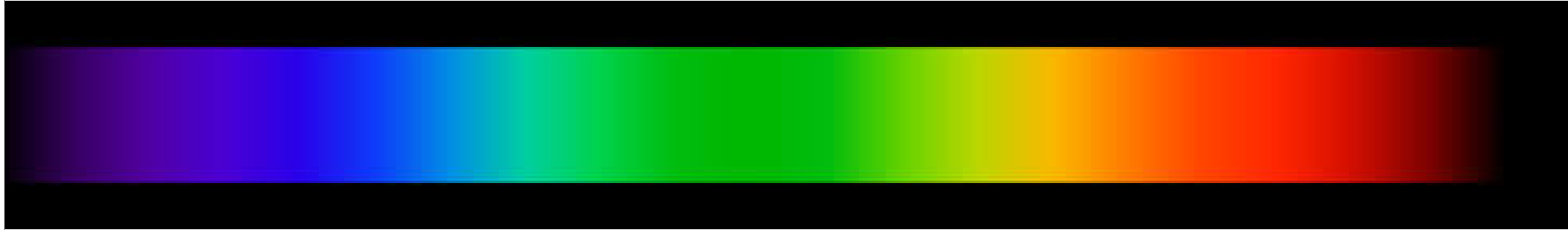
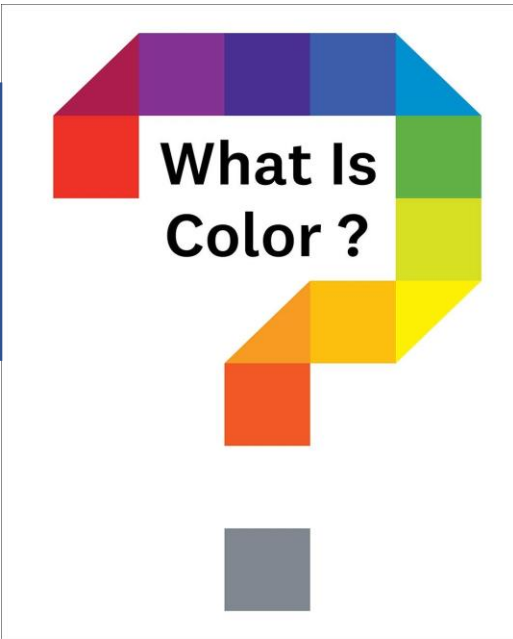
Texture- how would these feel

GEOMETRIC SHAPES

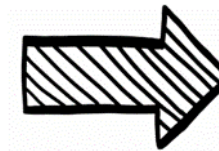
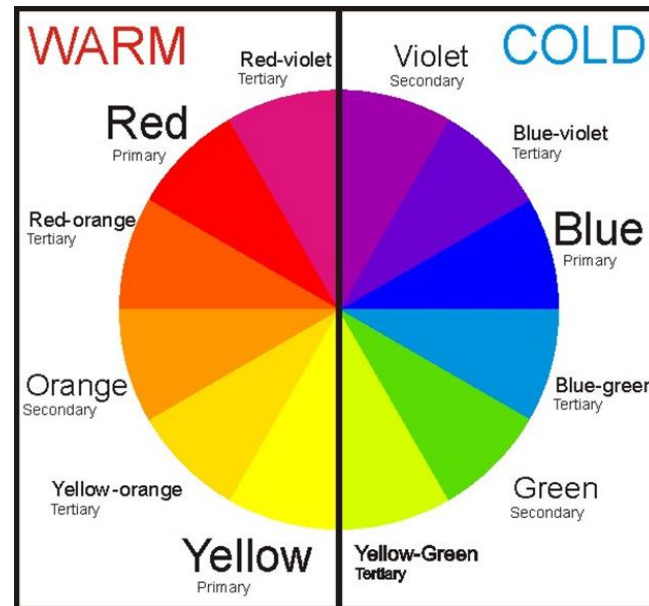
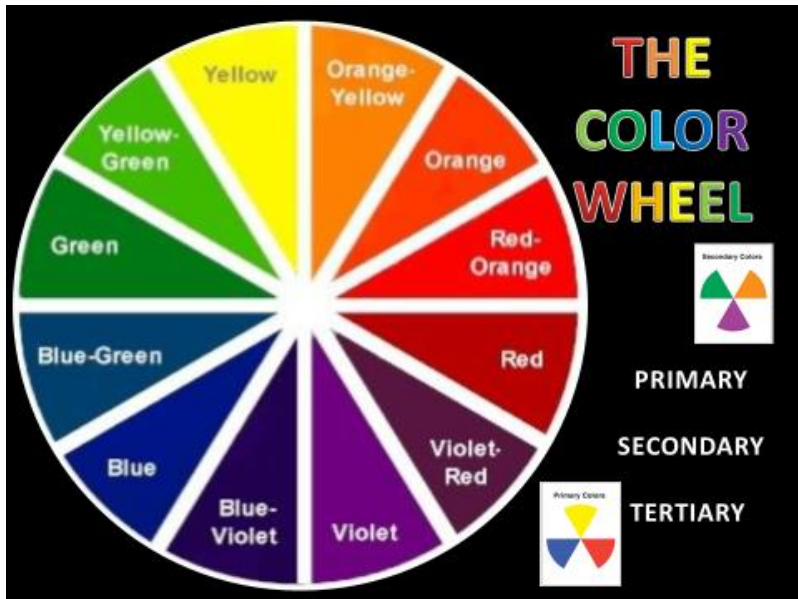

An exciting **ELEMENT** of art which depends on reflected light!



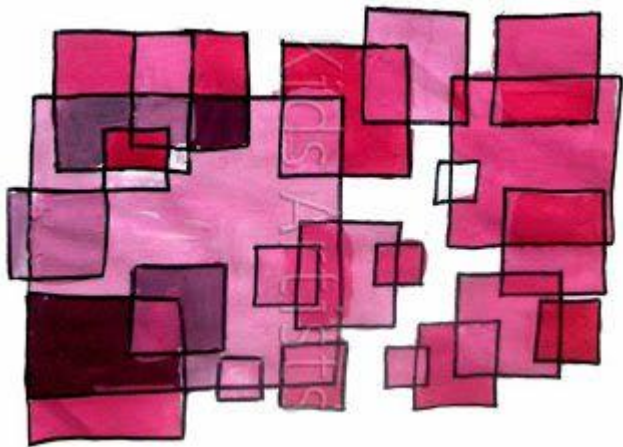
Warm/Cool Colors!

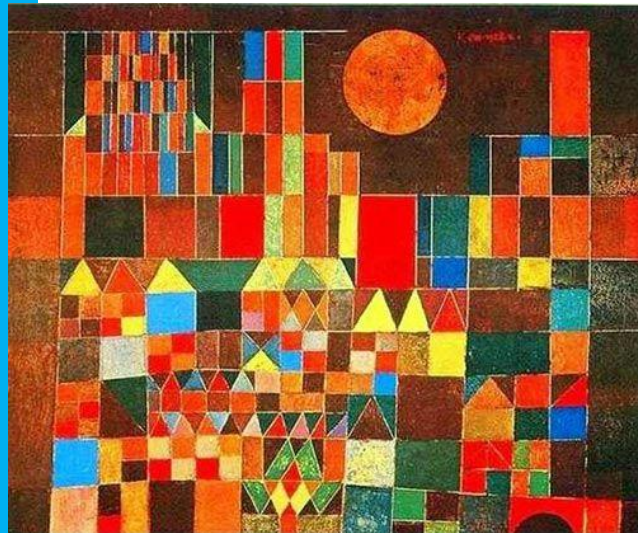
