

Confidential Student Username Tip Sheet



Please keep this information in a secure location at home.
DO NOT return this sheet to school.

Your child has several usernames and passwords that they will use to access various online resources. You may want to discuss with your student the usernames and passwords that he/she uses to access school related resources. These usernames include:

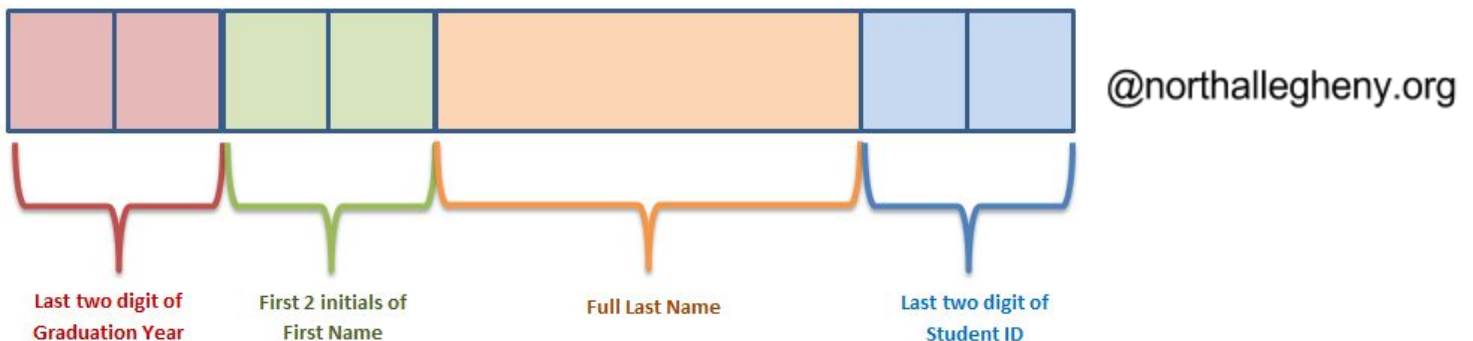
Student Number

This is a six-digit number that your child may know this as their “lunch number”.

This number, along with a password your student has set, is used to login into Windows computers in the District and to connect to WiFi from home.

Google Account/Student G-Mail Account

Your child’s Google account uses the naming convention below as a username.



This account is used to access Google Drive, the cloud storage system used by the District, and to access Gmail. Elementary student Gmail is restricted to messaging within the District. Additionally, your child will link several applications (Notability and Explain Everything) on the iPad to their Google Drive for easier file sharing. Your child’s Google password will match the password associated with his/her student number.

iPad Passcode

When your child set-up their iPad, he/she created a 4-6 digit passcode which unlocks the device.

If your child forgets their passcode, he/she will need to see the library secretary to have the passcode removed so that a new one can be set. Please be aware that the fingerprint passcode on an Apple device does not work when more than 48 hours have passed since the device has been unlocked. Students should not solely rely on fingerprint passcode to access their iPad.
