6th Grade Procedures

AM Homeroom

- Report to locker
- Gather all materials for AM classes (periods 1-3)
- Report to homeroom before the late bell
- Provide teacher with early dismissal or absent excuses from parents
- Quietly sit in assigned seat and wait for announcements

Activity Period

- Independent, quiet study period
- Ensure that you have all necessary homework and reading materials
 before entering the classroom
- Sign-out before leaving for an activity

Hall Passes

- Students must always have a pass when leaving the classroom
- Students must ask for teacher permission before leaving the room
- Follow classroom specific procedures, as required

General Reminders

- iPads must be **fully charged** at the beginning of the day
- All needed materials should be with you when you enter a class. You
 will not be allowed to return to your locker during class.
- Instruments will be stored in the music wing during the day. You should drop off/pick up instruments as you enter/leave the building.

Student Conduct Procedures

The 6th grade teachers would like to emphasize the following school rules:

- Personal electronic devices from home should be turned off and stored away when on school property (Student Handbook p. 40)
- School issued iPads are a "personal learning device" to be used for academic purposes only (Focus 2020 Policies on District website)
- Students are responsible for making up missed work due to absences. They must ask the teacher where they can find information on missed assignments (Student Handbook p. 14)
- Educational trips must receive approval from a building administrator at least five days before departing (Student Handbook p. 15)
- Students should adhere to the dress code (Student Handbook p. 46)

Tyler 360 - Gradebook

 - This is for work that is not expected to be made up
 - It will not affect students' grades
- A blank grade
 - Indicates that the teacher has not put the grade in the gradebook yet
 - Assignment is not necessarily missing
