Safety Training at North Allegheny

- Crisis teams meet regularly
- Standard Response Protocol
- Drills are conducted regularly
- Active Shooter Training
- Live active shooter training for administrators with CERT
- Stop the Bleed training through UPMC
- "To Go" kits in each classroom

Collaboration with Community Partners

- School, Community & Police Partnership
- Police Chief meetings
- School-based mental health liaisons
- Northern Area Superintendents & other regional collaboration opportunities



Physical Space & Building Procedures

- Visitors must be buzzed into the building (exterior door locks & video camera system)
- Single point of entry during the school day
- Capture vestibule in each building
- Visitor badges & Raptor Visitor Management System
- Consistent card key access for staff

School Climate

- NASD School Climate Survey
- *Measuring Success Framework* focuses on school climate, safety, and student wellness
- Beginning to design an advisory program for all District middle schools

Crisis Communications

- In a true emergency, parents/guardians are currently notified via School Messenger
- When there is no active emergency but communication is warranted, parents/guardians are notified via email

- Elementary Student Assistance Program (ESAP)
- Pupil Personnel Team (PPT) at the Middle and High Schools
- Student Assistance Program (SAP) Services
