



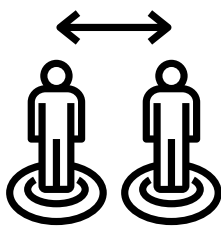

JANUARY 2021 HEALTH & SAFETY UPDATE



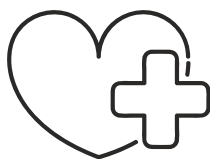
CLEANING, DISINFECTING, & VENTILATION

- Buildings are cleaned and disinfected nightly.
- HVAC systems are set to run more frequently to support increased air circulation and filtration.



SOCIAL DISTANCING & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- All students and staff are required to follow the PA Order on Face Coverings.
- Elementary homeroom classes will remain largely intact and separate throughout the day. Student class changes are limited. Large assemblies and activities are restricted.
- Middle School classes are switched by teams, limiting the number of students changing classrooms at one time.
- High School classes are dismissed incrementally to limit the number of students in the hallways. Volunteers are strictly limited.
- Transportation routes are shortened and bus stops consolidated.
 - Seating is based on the order of pickup.
 - Buses load from the rear to the front.



MONITORING STUDENT AND STAFF HEALTH

- The COVID-19 Tracker on the District's website is updated daily. Staff and families notified within a few hours of the District being notified of a case.
- The District is following state recommendations for Pre-K to 12 schools following the identification of a case of COVID-19 and will move to remote learning if needed.
- Staff and students are asked to check for symptoms before arriving to school. If they are sick, they must stay home.
