



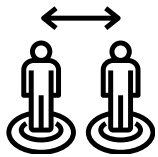

CLEANING, DISINFECTING, & VENTILATION

- Buildings are cleaned and disinfected nightly.
 - HVAC systems are set to run more frequently to support increased air circulation and filtration.

SOCIAL DISTANCING & SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- All students and staff are required to follow the PA Order on Face Coverings.
 - With appropriate documentation, Face Shields are an approved alternative to a cloth face covering.
 - Quarantine recommendations continue to include six feet of distance from the positive individual and others despite the CDCs updated guidance surrounding distance between students in school.

MONITORING STUDENT AND STAFF HEALTH

- Screen for symptoms daily: if you are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19, stay home!
 - If you or someone in your household are awaiting test results for COVID-19, you are advised to stay home until results come in.
 - If a family member who lives in your house is positive, please contact your school nurse before coming to school.
 - Proof of Positive Test results are to be submitted to your building nurse.
 - Antibody tests are not accepted as proof of a negative test.
 - At-home COVID tests are acceptable as long as they are FDA approved.
 - If you have been fully vaccinated against COVID or have a letter of exemption from your physician because of past infection with COVID in the past 90 days, please provide proof of these documents to your supervisor/school nurse for exemption from quarantine.
 - Proof of vaccination must be submitted to your students' school nurse.
