The survey will be available from March 20-31. School climate is an important part of North Allegheny's goal of providing a safe, welcoming, and well-maintained learning environment that promotes both academic and social/emotional growth for all students.

The school district will be looking to get feed back on Student Safety School Environment and Student Engagement. The kids in grade 4 and up will be surveyed as well during school. Parents of children grades 4 and up will be asked to respond as well. They will be asked to complete surveys for each child. If a parent only fills one out, they are asked to fill out the one for their youngest child.
