
Letters and Sounds Learning Game


A fun game to help students > learn and practice letters and sounds


Directions:


Print out, laminate (if possible), and cut apart all cards. Put all cards into bucket, cup, or box. Each child takes a turn pulling out a card. He/she needs to identify the letter and the sound, he/she then gets to keep the card. If the child pulls out an "Oh No!" card, he/she says (loudly with expression!), "Oh No!!!!" and then has to put all of his/her cards back in the bucket. The child with the most cards at the end wins! It seems like such a simple idea but the kids BEG to play it!
















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
