Figurative Language-Study Island

1. Watch this [video lesson](#) to complete 5 questions in Study Island together. Now you try it! Complete the 2m. Literal and Non-literal language practice session in Study Island to try to earn a blue ribbon (70% or higher). If you don't pass, try again this weekend with an adult.

Figurative Language Book Sharing

1. Watch this [sample video](#) of how to read your book with expression and how to show the pages to the camera.
2. Unstaple the pages of your book. Practice reading the book while showing each page to the camera. You will have 1 min. 30 seconds to record your video.
3. Find the Figurative Language Book Sharing assignment in Google Classroom.
4. Click on the link and enter your student I.D. (This is your lunch number)
5. Click the topic--Figurative Language Book Sharing
6. Set up the video camera or ask someone to videotape you. Click the + to start and stop recording. If you make a mistake, you may delete and start over.
7. Take a selfie to submit your video. (Your video needs to be previewed and approved by the teacher before others can view it. Don't worry if it looks like your video did not upload. Your teacher will notify you if you did not submit correctly.) You will be able to view your classmates' videos next week.

HOW TO use a QR Code

To use a QR code: Hover your phone or iPad camera over the code. The link will pop up at the top of your screen.
