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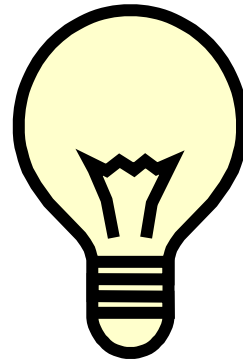

- If you have a lot of something or more than enough of something, you have

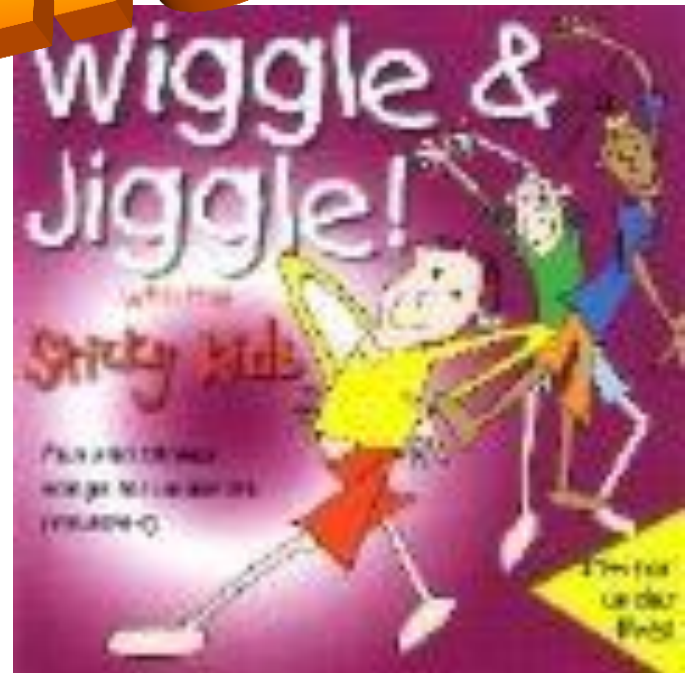
plenty
