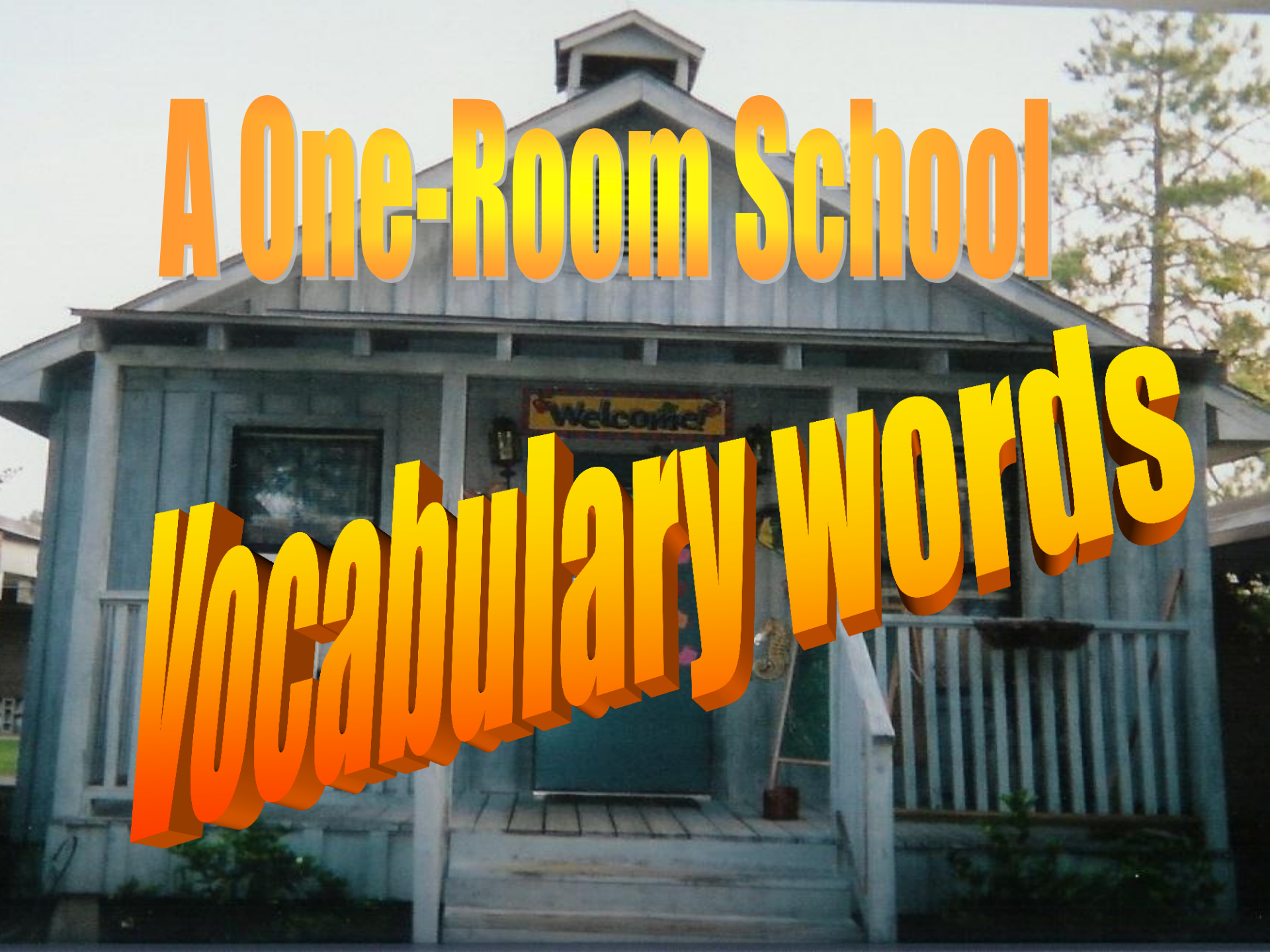

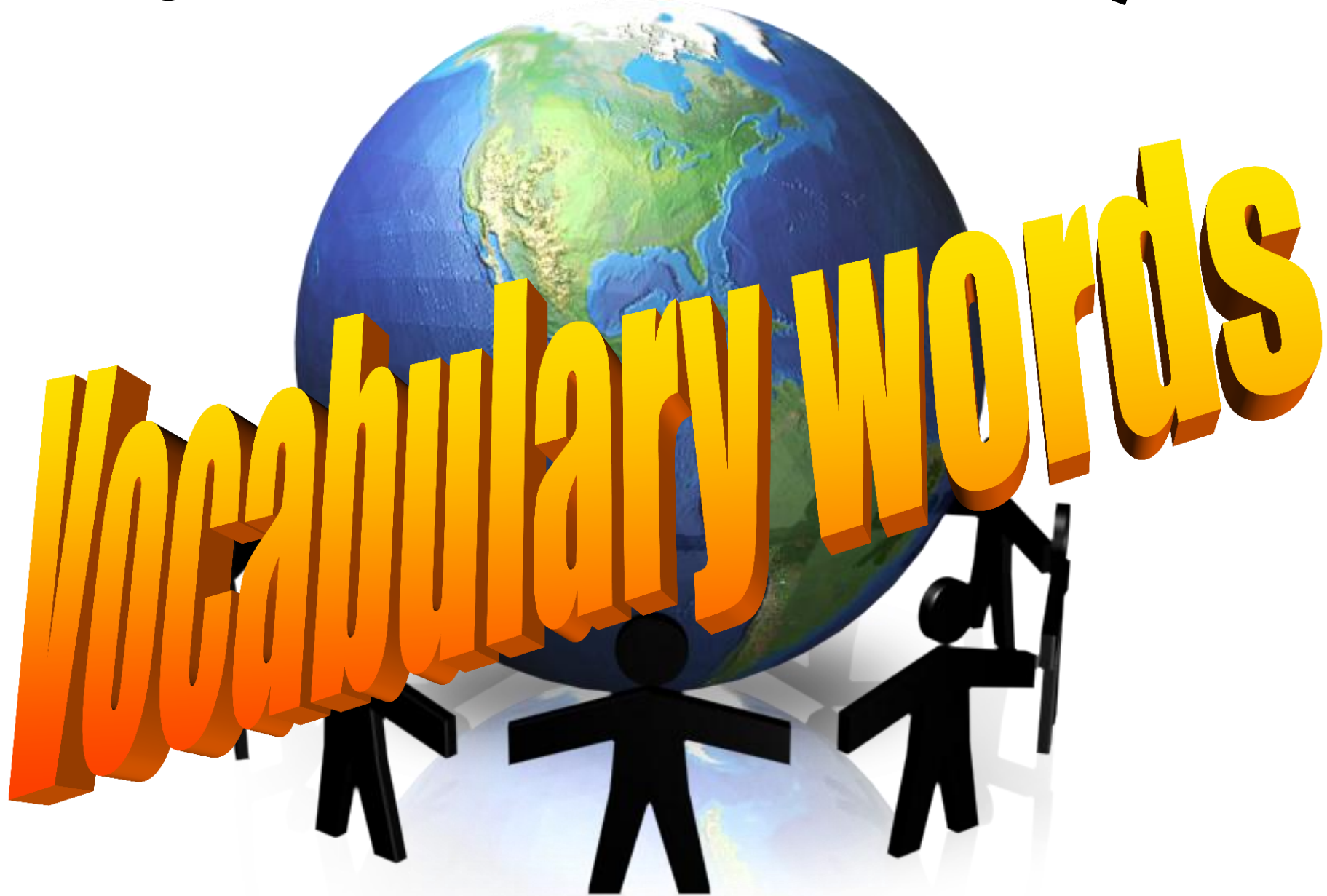

- Someone who helps another person with schoolwork is called a

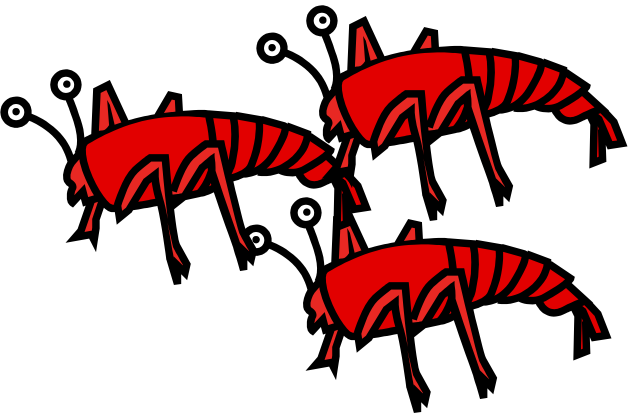

- If you have one particular thing it is a

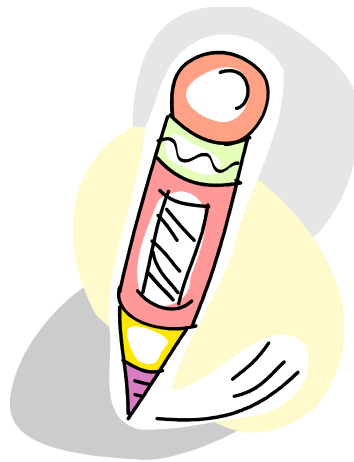
